Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.

Isaiah 41:10 ESV

For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, "Abba! Father!"

Romans 8:15 ESV

Fear is a powerful emotion. Some people fear things like bugs and animals, and some fear heights or confined spaces. I've met people who fear walking out of their own houses afraid of what could happen. Fear for many people is debilitating. Something that new and old Christians ask themselves is, "Should someone who believes in God live in fear?" The simple answer is no. We no longer have to live in fear. The one living God has given us His word, tools through prayer, and His one and only son so that we can live a life in His mercy and grace. He removed His people from slavery to live in freedom from oppression and fear.
