## Day 5—Thursday, August 16<sup>th</sup> In His Presence Prayer Focus—Side by Side Mentoring

Where can I go from your Spirit? Where can I flee from your presence? If I go up to the heavens, you are there; if I make my bed in the depths, you are there. If I rise on wings of the dawn, if I settle on the far side of the sea, even there your hand will guide me, your right hand will hold me fast.

Psalm 139:7-10 (NIV)

I raise my head forgiven, and wipe away my tears. God loves me. He enjoys being near. He holds me fast. Oh God, please help me become my best self. I'm reaching for your hand. Please hold me tight. Someday, I want to kneel at the feet of Jesus and hear him say, 'Well done, good and faithful servant'.

What a wonderful God! What a wonderful Father! Please don't worry about your worst–self moments. Instead reach for the hand of God and LIVE in his presence. He will guide you and hold you fast. He loves you when you are weak, and he loves you when you are strong. He loves you.
